Each board carries the unique nail holes, worm holes, mortise and tendon joins, and the rich, natural patina that can only come from wood aged through the years. Reclaimed flooring is available in Original Face (skip planed with saw marks present, slightly rougher finish, rarer) and Milled Face (milled and planed smooth).

Reclaimed Heart Pine features a bold patina and strong, long grain that make it a beautiful choice for a variety of interiors from rustic to eclectic to modern. The rich color variations of each board are often complimented by nail holes and other character marks to create a subtle and tasteful antique look.

Reclaimed Oak is sourced from old barns and buildings primarily in Pennsylvania and often feature wormholes, mortise holes, peg holes, natural cracks, checks and a lifetime of natural character. The variation of the red and white oak in the same floor creates an aged look that is unmatched, however red or white are available separately.
